Vernon Avenue) with the west line of Bela Badger and to the North to intersect the Present Road from Fourth Street in Columbus to Rodgers Harbor at or near John Mathew's June 2nd. 1827.

Beginning at the point where the Old Road leading from Franklinton to Newark crosses the West line of Bela Eadgers, half Section running from thence North to a large Maple in the line of George Stephenson quarter Township in the U.S. Military district at the North west Corner of John Mathews Clearing, Said to be on the road to Rogue harbour, the distance being One Mile and 71 1/2 poles.
