THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

We the subscribers land holders and residents in the said County think that a publick road through the township of Madison and in said County To Begin at the termination of the Circleville road in the Village of Middle Town, and continue to run in the same Direction Until It shall intersect the Center line of Section No. 1 Township No. 10 thence due North to intersect the Old State Road on the west line of lot belonging to Walter Henry; is Necessary and if established would be Conducive to public good Utility and convenience, Do hereby respectfully apply to and request of the Commissioners to appoint viewers to View the ground along which road is Proposed to be run Pursuant to the Statute in such Case made and Provided Dated July 27th. 1827.

Instant or within five days thereafter and after being duly sworn according to law Proceed to View Survey and Mark said Road and a true Plat and Survey thereof Return to this Board at their Next regular Session to be holden on the first Monday in the Month of March Next.

Persuant to an Order to us Directed from the board of Commissioners of Franklin County we have Viewed the ground for a proposed Road commencing at the termination of the Circleville Road in the Village of Middle Town thence with the Course of Circleville Street 40. Rods 38 links intersecting the center line of Section No. 1 T.N. 10, thence with the course of said line due North Crossing Walnut Creek at 142 Rods 13 links from the beginning thence North 42 West 11 Rods intersecting the center line of Section No. 36 T.N. 11. thence due North 178 Rods to a One Mile Stake, Course Continued 320 Rods Second Mile post Course Continued at 228 Rods.

Intersecting the State Road, we the Viewers beg leave to report that the ground over which said road is to run as good as could be expected in that Section of County and that we consider that such Road if opened would Conduce much to the Comfort and Convenience of the inhabitation thereof and be of much Publick Utility Dec. 18th. 1827.
