We the undersigned petitioner's being desirous of having a County Road Established on the East Side of Big Walnut through part of Mifflin & Blendon Township, Commencing on the John Storon Road at the north end of the Smith farm from thence Northarly to David Ridenhour's from thence the nearest and best Rout to Benjamin Moores from thence Northerly to Intersect a County Road leading from Simion Moore to Lees Mills, To which we the undersigned petitioner's humbly pray your honorable Body that Suitable persons May be appointed to View & Survey Sd. Road to which in duty bound we will ever pray, May 31st. 1831.

Agreably with an order for Surveying a Road through a Part of Mifflin and Blendon Town- ships on Petition of David Ridenours and Others, a Survey was made on June 24th. 1831 of which the Subjoined is a correct Return.

Commencing, on the Johnston Road at the N. end of the Smith farm in Mifflin Township, thence N.47° E. along Said Road 19 Poles, thence N.7° W. 74 poles, thence N. 100 poles, thence N.7° E.30 poles, thence N.20 poles, to David Ridenour's, Same course 20 poles, N.18° W.57 poles 1. Mile Same course 320 poles 2 Miles Same course 14 poles. W.78 poles, N.21° W. 66 poles to Township line N.11° W. by B. Moores 84 poles N. 15° W.42 poles, N.30° W. 36 poles to 3 Miles Same 19 poles to a County Road leading from Simion Moore's to Lees Mills Total 3 Miles and 19 poles.

We the undersigned having Superintended the location of the above discribed Rout for a Road do Report favourable for the establishing and opening of the Same Given under our hands this 24th. day of June 1831.
