JOHN MCCOY PETITION FOR ALTERATION

TO

THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY OHIO

The undersigned land holders of Said County Respectfully beg leave to State that tract of land lying in Perry Township owned by John McCoy is greatly and unfairly cut up by three or four roads running transversley through the Same, one running up the river one down the same, one in the direction of Worthington and one running eastwardly to the Mouth of the lane South of J. Thomas to the Mill on the Scioto River, We therefore pray that your Board do at the Meeting thereof in June next appoint three Viewers and a Surveyor to alter that part of the last Mentioned road from where it crosses the west boundary lands of John McElvane or Wm. Domigan Dec'd to McCoy's Mills by running from said West Boundary South 45° West until that course intersects the Military boundary Thence with Said boundary West to the road leading up the east Bank of Said River and with Said road to Said McCoy's Mill and to Vacate the part of Said Road between the West boundary and Mill aforesaid 20th. May 1831.

Pursuant to an order of the Commissioners of Franklin County, I proceeded under the directions of the Viewers Therein Named, to Survey the Rout herein Protracted for a Road, (to wit).

Beginning in the Road from the end of Thomas lane to McCoys Mill where it crosses the line of J. McElvain's land at a post between a Small red oak and burr Oak marked as Witnesses, thence Run South 45° through the Woods 234 poles to an ash Burr oak, Red oak & Hickory in the Military boundary line, thence with Said line West 126 poles to a Stake in the Road running up Scioto River on the east Side, to McCoys Mill Near the N.W. Corner of O'Harra's field, thence with Said Road N.27°W.50 poles N.45°W. 168 poles to a hickory on the S.W. Side of Said Road and N.37°30" W.210 poles to the first mentioned Road, and with Said Road S.53°W.43 poles to a Large Stone near the mill Making the whole distance 831 poles, The first mentioned Road as herein protracted, between the points aforesaid is found to measure 645 poles making the proposed Rout for a Road 186 Poles longer than the road now traveled.

Shrum's lane, on whetstone River, Running from thence westwardly to McCoy's Mill on Scioto River, having carefully measured the original Road, as well as the Rout which Said Petitions have Prayed to be adopted, and finding it to be on better ground than the former, and that the convenience of the inhabitants on the Scioto River will be better----- by the Prayed for alterations, and that they will thereby be better enabled to concentrate their labour on the highway, on that Part of the Road Running Paralel with the Scioto River, We the undersigned there-fore, in Conformity with the Prayer of the Petitioners have come to the conclusion, that the prayers ought to be granted.
