THE HONOURABLE board of COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

Your Petitioners humbly Represents that John French has laid out the Town of Unity or Reynoldsburgh on the National Road, where the Road from Lancaster through Jacksonville to Delaware, on the east Side of Blacklick crosses N.S. Road, the Lancaster Street Crosses the N.S. Road, with the Said County Road, and Running a few degrees South of the Old Road, Your Petitioners think it will be of Publick utility, to change or alter the Said County Road, South of the N.S. Road So as to follow the Lancaster Street in Said Town to South Street, then on a Straight line to intersect the Old Road at or Near the South line of Said John French's land, and that Suitable Viewers and Surveyors be appointed to Make the Said Alterations, the Alteration of which will be Seen by Examoning the Plat of Said Town, in duty bound your Petitioners will ever Pray Nov. 24th. 1831.
