Ramseys on the Lancaster road) being laid on the line of Hamilton and Madison townships so far as the road runs with said line we therefore pray your honorable body to appoint three suitable men to View said road and lay it on said townships line and to continue it from G. White, up to intersect the national road on J. Barrs farm at a point near where the present road crosses the national road.
