TO THE HONOURABLE COMMISSIONERS OF OF FRANKLIN COUNTY NOW IN SESSION

Gentlemen,

Finding my Self Much Injured by the location of a State Road recently run and returned by Jonathan Holmes and John Wilson commencing at the farm called Jonathan Holmes in Pickaway County to the Cayanna run in Franklin County, your Petitioner would therefore, Pray your honourable body, to appoint Suitable men, to view and estimate the damages, I have Sustained in Consequence of the location of said Road aforesaid as in duty bound Shall ever Pray.

It is therefore Ordered by the Commissioners of Franklin County that Robert Cloud, David Nelson and John Barr be and they are hereby appointed to View Such part of Said Road as passes through the land of the heirs of Thomas Johnston decess'd and that they Meet at the Office of Thos" West Esq. in the Town of Columbus on the 3rd. day of August or within five days thereafter, and be qualified to proceed to View as aforesaid and estimate the damages if any and report the Same to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of Dec. Next.
