COL. JAS. KILBOURNE PETITION FOR ALTERATION CIRCLEVILLE
STATE ROAD

TO

THE HONOURABLE THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

The undersigned free holders and Citizens of Said County do Very respectfully represent, that the Interest of both the Publick, and several individuals owning lands in the Sotherin part of Said County will in are opinion, be Much promoted, by an alteration or change in the State Road recently layed out by William Long and David Domilson Esq. from Circleville to Columbus (towit) beginning in the line established for Said Road at a Point where the Same intersects the division line between the farms of Michael Stimmel and James Lindsey, and Running thence, Southeastwardly, on such course as to intersect the present traveled Road Near Matthias Woolf's house, in which Isaac Lambert Now resides, and thence to a point in Said Road Near the dwelling of David Sloan; all of Which points are within the County of Franklin and Township of Hamilton, No Change being proposed at the line of Said County the distances between the two Remotest points from each other being about 3½ Miles More or less. We do therefore Most Respectfully Request that your Honourable body will cause the Necessary Proceeding to be taken in the premises so as a New Road May be established, and the present Road Vacated between the points aforesaid according to the act in such case made and provided.

To Jacob Grubb, Colbert Stewart and Reubin Callida Esq. Viewers for a change of location of a part of the State road from Circleville by Lockbourn to Columbus discribed by the annexed Order, agreeable to your View, and directions, and with the Necessary Assistance, I have surveyed, and Marked, the line for the proposed Change as follows. In Conformity to the annexed Order, of the Honourable Commissioners of said County, we the undersigned, Viewers, assisted by James Kilbourne as Surveyor, appointed for the Purpose, with other necessary hand having previously, on a former order, Viewed the ground proposed for a change of so much of the State road leading from Circleville by Lockburn to Columbus, as is Situate between a point in Said road, at or near the line of Michael Stimmel and James Lindseys farms, and dwelling house of David Sloans in Hamilton Township in Said County and being of opinion, that the Publick interest, will be essentially promoted, by the proposed change, we have caused the Same to be Surveyed and Marked accordingly as the law requires, as will more fully appear by the annexed Plat and Survey bill made and Subscribed to by the Surveyor, appointed as aforesaid, and by us approved all of which is Submitted to the honourable board of Commissioners.

1.237. Whereupon Alex. Crone, Matthias Woolf, Phos. Morris, Wm. McCune, J. Lindsey's.Hr", John Wilson, Jacob Fisher, Jas. CulbertsonHr" And" Culbertson Hr" and Thomas Johnson Heirs, filed their several Petitions for damages on this as well as the original located rout.

Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Isaac Harrison of Blendon Township, John Sharp of Hamilton Township and Stephan L. Peck of Clinton Township as Viewers of damages on the aforesaid Petitions who afterward to wit on the 13th. day of Nov. 1834 were severally Sworn and Made the following report (To wit).

According to an Order of the Commissioners of Franklin County Ohio Dated July 25th. 1834 wherein we Isaac Harrison, S.S. Peck and John Sharp, being Ordered to View and estimate the damages on a certain State Road, leading from Circleville to Columbus, as Viewed Wm. Long and Dav"d Donnilson, and also a certain alteration, as Petitioned for by Col. James Kilbourn and Others.

We therefore having Viewed the premises of those Claiming Under Said Order, the two different routs or Surveys as set forth in Said Order and report as follows.
