TO

THE HONOURABLE THE COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO

The petition of the undersigned, free holders of the County of Franklin represent that their interest and Convenience requires, the location and establishment of a County road, Commencing at the State Road, at the E. end of Alex. Mooberry's lane, being the line between Truro and Montgomery Townships, thence Nearly east Along the N. Side of the improvement of the heirs of Daniel Ross dec'd thence to strike along the N. side of the improvements of John Courtright, thence along the N. side of Solomon Schoolts's and Blashing from thence to Intersect the lane between John Stambaugh and the Hs of Baltser Shults de'd thence along Said lane, to the end thereof, thence to Strike along the N. Side of the big run to the upper end of the Mill embankment, thenc on a Straight line to Strike the lower row of apple trees in the Orchard of Elias Chester Sen., thence to the South along the lane of Said Chester to the hill, thence along the top of the hill to the line between Madison and Truro Townships, thence E. along Said line to Big Walnut Creek, thence down the Creek to the first ripple for a ford, thence up on the E. bank the the Township line, thence along Said line to intersect the Bigsbee road Near the Truro Meeting House, and your Petitioners therefore Pray that the Proper and legal steps May be taken to Authorize the location and establishment of said road dated this 5th. day of January 1834.

Pursuant to the annexed order, I Proceeded on the 23rd. May 1834, to Make a Survey of the ground for a road therein Specified as follows (Viz.).

Beginning at a post the E. end of Alex. Mooberry's lane and on the E. Side of the road leading from Columbus to Lancaster running E. along the N. Side of the improvement of the H's of Dan'l Ross, 160 Poles to a post, thence S. 80° E. 71 poles to a post, thence N. 88° E. along the N. side of John Courtrights improvement 89 poles to 1st. Mile Tree, thence 80° E. 82 poles to a post, thence S. 75° E. along N. side of John Sternbaugh's 86½ poles to a post, thence S. with Sternbaugh's E. line 30 Poles to a post, thence S. 44½° E. 82 Poles to a post, thence S. 36° E. along the N. Side of the big Run 39½ poles to the 2 Mile post, thence Continued same Course 8½ poles to a White walnut on the bank of the run, thence S. 4° E. through E. Chester's lane 73 poles to a post, thence S. 39° E. 45 poles to a post in the line dividing the Townships of Truro and Madison, thence E. with said line Crossing the run at 29 poles 193½ poles to 3 Mile post, thence continued same course 170 poles to a post on the Bank of Big Walnut, thence S. 8½° E. 46 poles to a post on the banks of the Creek, thence N. 56° E. Crossing the Creek 16 Poles to a post on the E. bank, thence 8½° W. 36½ poles to a Post in the above Mentioned line, thence E. with Said line 57½ Poles to 4 Mile Tree, thence Continued E. with Said line 66 poles to a post in the Byxbee road, Nearly oposithe Truro Meeting House Whole distance 4 Miles 66 Rods.
