Pursuant to the foregoing Order, I proceeded On the 25th. day of June 1834 under the direction of the Viewers, therein Named to Make a Survey of the alteration as therein directed as follows (to Wit).

Beginning at a post in the Center of the road and running N.7 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^o W. With the Present traveled route 49 $\frac{3}{4}$ Poles to the Nation Road, directly in front of Greenwood House, Passing South line at 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ Poles from the beginning Point to that distance 49 $\frac{3}{4}$ poles.

To the Commissioners of Franklin County,
Gentlemen,

We have examoned the ground for the proposed Alterations in the road as Specified in your Order, but find that the traveled tract, Crosses Greenwood's line east of the Old Road, we therefore recommend and are of Opinion, that the road ought to be located as designated by the Surveyor's Plat and Survey as herewith returned and that the Old Road be Vacated between the beginning Point and the National Road.
