PETITION OF J. GRUBB AND OTHERS TO THE HONOURABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF FRANKLIN COUNTY

The Petition of the undersigned respectfully represent to your board, the publick law and Convenience require the location of a County Road, Commencing at the North end of Washington street in the town of Franklinton, and thence Northerly with Said Street across the Scioto river until it intersects the State road on the east side of the Scioto river leading from Columbus to Delaware County, and your petitioners therefore pray, that the proper and legal steps May be taken to authorize the location and establishment of said road, and will ever pray etc.

Beginning at the North end of Washington Street in the town of Franklinton, thence with the course or bearing of said street N.11 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. and across the Scioto River 27 Poles to a srake in the road leading up said River.
