The following are the field

Notes describing the State Road Surveyed by me under your direction and viewed from Worthington in Franklin County to Galena in the County of Delaware. Having commenced the examination of the route at Worthington and continued the same by survey experimental lines, and otherwise, the final location is as follows (viz)

Beginning at the west line of said Valley of Galena, near Carpenters Grist mill and running thence 1st Course S. 73° W. 70 poles, set angle post on top of a Hill
2nd Course S. 48° W. at 1 Mile a post and back tree: at 2nd Mile a post in field at 2nd Mile 86 poles angle post in old State road, 3rd Course S. 28° 45' W. at 3 Miles a post in said old road, at 3 Miles 232 poles angle post Southwesterly of Wm G. Campbell's Farm. 4th Course S. 30° 25' W. at 4 Miles a post and Back at 5 Miles a post and Back at 5 Miles 174 poles County Road near S. C. Baldwins dwelling
5th Course S. 30° W. at 5 Miles 284 poles angle post on east bank of Allen Creek
6th Course S. 42° W. at 5 Miles 292 poles West bank same Creek 7th Course S. 47° W. at 6 Miles a post and Back at 6 Miles 40 poles Big Rock Run to G. E. large at 6 Miles 120 poles small run at 6 Miles 210 poles small run, at 7 Miles a post and Back at 7 Miles 6 poles a small run, at 7 Miles 94 poles Turkey Run large at 7 Miles 120 poles small branch of Turkey Run, at 7 Miles 275 poles N. fork of Yorks brook, large, at 7 Miles 294 poles, small run, into Yorks brook, at 8 Miles a post and Back, at 8 Miles 94 poles S. fork of Yorks brook, large, at 8 Miles 186 poles N. side of Cat Swamp, at 8 Miles 200 poles. S. side same, at 8 Miles 260 poles Main Jacobs brook, at 9 Miles post and Back, at 9 Miles 42 poles S. fork of Jacobs brook and wide swale bay 8 poles, at 9 Miles 189 poles angle post, 8th Course S. 45° 50' W. at 9 Miles 234 poles small run from E. to W. into Rush brook, at 9 Miles 254 poles N. part of Rush brook at an island, at 9 Miles 264 poles S. part Rush brook at island, at 10 Miles a post and Back, at 10 Miles 144 poles Wash brook small, at 10 Miles 210 poles, Wash brook with deep ravine, at 11 Miles a post in S. corner field, at 11 Miles 11 poles Turnpike Road. at Mile post N. 97. 9th Course due South at 11 Miles 33 poles N. line of Worthington.
