State Road

From Gordon in Madison Co. to Lancaster in Fairfield Co.
via Lockbourne

Pursuant to an act of the general assembly of the State of Ohio, passed March 3^d 1834, to lay out and establish a State Road from the Town of Gordon in Madison County by Lockbourne in Franklin County and Lythopolis in Fairfield County to the Town of Lancaster in Fairfield County; Whereby Henry Warner of Madison, John Bishop of Bladen Township Franklin County and Jacob Cowan of Fairfield County, were appointed Commissioners, and Oziel Jeffries of Fairfield County was appointed Surveyor to lay out and establish the same. The Henry Warner, and Jacob Cowan, Commissioners in conjunction with Oziel Jeffries, Surveyor, met in obedience to said act at the Town of Gordon in Madison County, and after taking to awe assistance John Gunn and George W. Gacy, Chain Carriers, and Richard Newmarker with such other assistance as we considered necessary (all being sworn according to law of whom the Statute of Ohio, requires an obligation under oath), Proceeded on the 28th day of July 1834, to commence the view survey and establishment of said Road, which we continued until completed, as follows. Beginning at the crossing of the street in Gordon. Near the S.E. Corner of the Public Square thence to the Town of Lockbourne in Franklin County, thence to the Pickaway County line, thence with the Pickaway and Fairfield County line, to a point near the line of Fairfield County, thence to the Town of Lythopolis, and from thence to Lancaster in Fairfield County, as is fully expressed by the following plat. And after viewing several tracts and parts of tracts, some of which we surveyed we are of opinion, that the best represented by the Plat,

the best and most suitable for a road, therefore we do establish said Road on the above described route, and as represented by the plot, Given under our Hands and Seals at Columbus this 16th day of December A.D. 1834
