

State Road

From 10 Mile Stone on Station Road to Buffords in Madison County

We the undersigned being appointed by the Register for the purpose of locating a State Road to Commence at a point on the National Road Ten Miles west of Columbus, and after being duly sworn, and taken to our assistance Henry Warner Surveyor, proceeded on the 10th 11th 12th & 13th days of June (1834) to locate said Road. Beginning at the point aforesaid, and running from thence S. 11. 30th W. 320 poles to 1st Mile Tree, same course 2nd Mile Tree, same course 3rd Mile Tree, same course 298 poles, to the Georgesville Road (So. Cauley,) thence with the same S. 72nd W. 22 poles to 4th Mile Tree, thence S. 80th W. 106 poles, thence S. 57th W. 97 poles, passing down the Main Street of Georgesville, and crossing Big Darby at and immediately below the mouth of Little Darby, thence S. 84th W. 52 poles, thence S. 62th W. 40 poles thence S. 35th W. 40 poles to 5th Mile Tree, same course 320 poles to 6th Mile Tree, thence S. 29th W. 320 poles to 7th Mile Tree, and the line between the County of Franklin & Madison same course 12 poles, thence S. 15th W. 38 poles, thence S. 22nd W. 50 poles, crossing the Big Run, thence S. 31st W. 270 poles to 8th Mile Tree, same course 152 poles, thence S. with the line between Stuvant & Stovant 168 poles to 9th Mile Tree, thence S. 21st W. 94 poles, thence S. 11th W. 108 poles to a large stump in the land between Oglesville & Henderson, thence S. 118 poles, passing the W. E. Corner of Hendersons land to the 10th Mile Tree, same course 36 poles, thence S. 37th 30th W. 284 poles to 11th Mile Tree, same course 320 poles to 12th Mile Tree, same course 316 poles thence S. 36th W. 14 poles to 13th Mile Tree, thence same course 54 poles, crossing Deerfucker, and John Hious Mill race. Near where the Mill Head, the second point named in the act for locating said road, thence S. 2nd E. 40 poles thence S. 23rd W. 40 poles, thence S. 68th W. 166 poles passing through John Grahams land to 14th Mile Tree same course 92 poles. Intersecting the Chuluckin Road near William Buffords last point named in said act total distance 10 Miles 192 poles. 7 Miles of which is in Franklin County
