The petition of the subscribers land holders and inhabitants of the Townships of Washington Norwich and Perry respectfully sheweth

That your petitioners labors under great disadvantages for the want of a County Road Commencing at Shaddocks Bough, in Perry Township, and running in a westerly direction, and crossing the Great line, at or near Hutchinsons Mill, thence on the W. side of Hayden Run to M. Cans Sugar Camp, thence on the N. side of said Run to the N. E. Corner of Smiths Poles improvement, thence N. to the N. 30° W. to do, thence N. 20° W. to do, thence N. 15° W. to do to the dwelling house of Wm Harris thence N. to the County line, near the Town of Amity, and in granting this petition your petitioners will ever pray

Crackin Esq. in Norwich Township on the 16th day of March 1835, and after being duly qualified, according to law proceed to View, Survey Mark and locate said Road, and a Tree plot and Survey thereof, along with their report return to this office, on or before the first Monday in the Month of June next

Pursuant to the annexed Order. I proceeded on the 16th day of March 1835, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, to make a Survey of the Road as petitioned for as follows (viz) Beginning at a point in Shaddocks bough, where the line between Pierce & Shaddock intersects the road, passing through said Bough thence N. with the line of Pierce & Shaddock 195 poles to angle post, thence N. 45° W. 122 poles to a Buck 1 Mile Tree. Continued same Course 276 poles to a Buck angle Tree. Crossing branch at 44 poles, thence N. 89° W. Crossing branch at 10 poles 44 poles to a Buck 2 Mile Tree. Continued same Course. Crossing branch at 58 poles 108 poles to A. Hutchinsons. N. E. Corner. Continued same Course into Hutchinsons W. line 104 poles, to the Center of the State Road. Leading up the E. bank of the Great line, thence with the road N. 25° W. 78 poles to 2 Mile post. Continued same Course 24 poles to Hutchinsons Cross. thence S. 71° W. Crossing the line 52 poles to the Center of the Road. Leading to Wandusky, thence with the road S. 10° W. 64 poles to a large Stone, thence S. 30° W. 33 poles to a Buck angle Tree. on the bank of Hayden Run. thence of the run on the S. side S. 80° E. 44 poles to Buck 1/2 Mile Tree. Continued same Course 18 poles to Buck

 leading to Columbus through Norwich Township, thence N. on said State Road  
 about thirty rods, thence Northwesterly, until it strikes the farm of Smiths Pootin  
 in Washington Township, and thence to the County line, in the direction of

Striking the Town of Amity on Big Darby,

That the County Road recently established in Washington Township, and which is partly opened, Commencing at the S. end of Sipe Millers Run thence Westwardly in the direction of the said Town of Amity, in Madison County, and which is partly opened, affords very Messy and Connuicand, and owing to the scarcity of hands, in this Settlement, requires all the labour that can be procured, to finish & opening and Completing the same, that the proximity of said Road to the, aiming at said Town of Amity, and which nearly unite in Washington Township at the County line, Shows the inexpediency of opening the former Road at this time, and which we are fully persuaded, the opinion of any disinterested men would acquiesce that your petitioners view and applaud the idea of opening and establishing publick. but at the same time, do in the most solemn manner, protest against an unnecessary establishment, and therefore pray your Honorable body, to adopt such Measures as shall relieve them from the burden herein complained off, and your petitioners shall ever pray, Moss Davis, Zephoniah Rodgers, Charles Mitchell, E. To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County, We the Citizens of the Town of Amity, and its vicinity around Sipe in Madison County, would forward to you our requests, for you if it can please your Honours, to grant and establish, the New Contemplated Road, leading from Shallocks Branch to the County line, for it is not consistent, nor reasonable that we should meet the one Mr. Coffman, had laid out, for we dont conceive it will be any benefit to us, but we feel interested in the New locality Road. And shall petition to our Commissioners, as soon as your Honours, shall grant what is now located, and by so doing you will oblige your petitioners,
