To the Honorable board of Commissioners of Franklin County,

We the undersigned petitioners, and free holders in Said County beg lean to represent, to your Honourable body, that we labour under great, disadvantage, for want of a Road, leading in a direction from Dublin to Hintons Milk on Mill Creek, and that we believe that a Road laid out, in that direction, would be of great advantage to the publick, therefore your petitioners humbly pray your Honourable body, to grant a Road, Beginning at the State Road, lately laid out from Worthington to Marysville, at a point exactly on the Course of the line between Eliod Sells and Asahel Parmenter, thence to the Corner of Sells and Parmenter's land, North 19 W. thence with their line, and the Same line of Survey, to the line of Franklin and Delaware Counties, to Meet a Contemplated road through a Corner of Delaware County, and intersects a Contemplated Road in Union County, leading to Hintons Mill, in granting the prayer of the petition, you will confer a particular favor on your petitioners, and greatly increase the publick advantage, and your petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray ect.
