Alteration to the State Road,
north and south of Bethel Road

BY S. MAYNARD AND OTHERS FOR ALTERATION

ROW = 60'

To the Honourable the Commissioners of Franklin County,
 We the undersigned, freeholders and residence of Said County. Petitioners, Represent to your Honourable body, that an alteration of the State Road, leading from Franklinton in Said County, up the west bank of the Olentangy River to Delaware in Delaware County, as follows. Commencing in the Center of the State Road, oposite the House of Hiram Andrews. in Clinton Township from thence Northwardly, on a Straight line to intersect Said Road a little South of the Old distilery belonging to Azeniah Pinney in Sharon Township, and extend the County Road, as petitioned for by Hiram Andrews. and Others, that Commenced at Said Road, on the line between Sharon and Clinton Townships and run Westwardly to the Highway on the east bank of the Scioto River, So far east as to intersect the New location of Said State Road. and to Vacate the Old State Road, So far as the New location May be established, Would be of Public Utility, and that you proceed, according to the Statute in Such Case Made and provided May 27th 1835 Assaph Allen, W. S. Spencer, Wm Vining. H. A. Case, Asael Ingham, Abraham Ingham, Eli Hall, E. Maynard, John Dawson, B. H. Shields, Freeman Shields, Stephen Maynard Harding Pierce, Samuel Andrews, Whereupon the Commissioners, appointed Oliver Miller, C. Cook and A. Walker, as Viewers and Fred Cole Surveyor, and that they Meet at the office of Isaac Case Esq, in Sharon Township on the 19th of Aug. 1835 or within five days, thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed, to View, Survey. Mark and locate Said Roads, and a true plat and Survey thereof along with your Report, Return, to this office, on or before the first Monday in Dec. Next. June 3rd 1835

To the Honourable the Commissioners of franklin County
 Agreeable to your Order to us directed of the 19th Uto in answer to a petition of Stephen Maynard and Others for the alteration of a Part of the State Road leading from the Town of franklinton to the Town of Delaware, and also to extend the County Road, as petitioned for by H. Andrews, and Others We proceeded on the 19th inst, to an examination and survey of the ground, and location of the Road, as follows, Viz, Beginning at a point in the Road leading from the Town of franklinton to Delaware. N. 59 E. 5 poles 21 links from the front door of H. Andrews house, Running N. 29° W. 160 Rods to a point in Said State Road South of the distilery of A. Pinney in Sharon Township, Crossing the line, dividing the Township of Sharon and Clinton at 72 Rods and 20 links, making the distance in favour of the alteration between the points of Section with the old Road 4 Rods. We extended the County Road as petitioned for by H. Andrews and Others from the Beginning point East, to the point of intersection, with the line of Said alteration, Making a distance of 5 Rods and 19 links, We believe the establishment of Said Roads would add to the Convenience of the publick and of Utility to the Same
