To the honorable Commissioners of Franklin County We laboring Serious difficulties from want of an established Road from the South West corner of Franklin County to State Road at Darby Creek at Georgesville the difficulties are these there was a kind of Road used at an early day circuitous in its Course running out and into Several Counties and is not worked nor has it been for many years but is much traveled it is also fenced up in many places so that travelers cannot pass without throwing down fences to the great detriment of the proprietor We the undersigned freeholders of Said County pray you to grant us a Road far nearer beginning at the London Road near the South West corner of Franklin County Running the nearest and best way to intersect an established Cart Road on the West side of John Biggarts farm Running with said Cart Road to the State Road at the junction of Big and little Darby Creeks otherwise to intersect the County Road above James Walkers both being alike eligible leaving the choice to the Viewers while we Remain your humble petitioners Balzar Mantle John G. Garritson George Goodson John Biggart Joseph Barker Thos Tipton Thos Roberts. Whereupon it is ordered by the Commissioners of Franklin County that Josiah Bivins Hiram Lakins and Duke Story be and they are hereby appointed to View Said Road and F. Cole be and is hereby appointed Surveyor of the Same and that they meet at the office of W. Walker in Pleasant Township on the fifteenth day of Feb 1836 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report Return to this office on or before the 1st Monday of March 1836

Story Viewers to make a Survey of the Road and locate the Same as follows (Viz) Beg'g at a Stake in the London Road on the line dividing the land of Balser and Saml Mantle Near the South West Corner of Franklin County Running from thence N. 19 W. 106 Rods N. 16 E. 214 Rods to an Elm Marked 1 Mile Contd Same Course 189 Rods to W. Oak angle tree thence N. 29 E. 131 Rods to W. Oak marked 2 Miles Contd Same Course 137 Rods to a Hickery in the line of an Established Cart Way thence with Said Cart way N. 21 1/2 E. 48 Rods Thence N. 10 E. 72 Rods to an Elm angle tree Thence N. 47 1/2 E. 40 Rods Thence N. 26 E. 23 Rods to a Buckeye Marked 3 Miles Contd Same Course 8 Rods to a Black Walnut angle tree Thence N. 9 W, 94 Rods Thence N. 24 1/2 W. 84 Rods Thence N. 28 W. 40 Rods Thence N. 5 W. 10 Rods to a Stake in the Creek 4 Miles Contd Same Course 66 Rods Thence N. 30 E. Crossing the Creek 74 Rods to the West Bank Thence N. 45 1/2 E. 74 Rods to the Creek Thence Crossing the Creek N. 60 E. 14 Rods to a Maple in the County Road on the East Bank above J. Walken Making the total distance 4 miles 228 Rods.
