COUNTY ROAD Walnut Street

BY NATHAN CHEEVOR et al

To the honorable Board of Commissioners of Franklin County

The memorial of the undersigned freeholders of Said County Respectfully Represents that they Conceive it would conduce to the public Convenience if a County Road was established as follows Viz. Commencing at the School house near Francis Climers in Plain Township and running west on the best ground to the ford across Big Gahannah Creek near B. Carrs from thence westwardly to the east end of the lane between N. Cheevors and S. Brenckerhoof from thence west to intersect the Alum Creek Road near John Bishops and we solicit that Viewers may be appointed to View the Same and make Report to you according to law Oct. 29th 1835 Whereupon it is ordered by the Commissioners of Franklin County that Isaac Griswold George Osborn Edward Phelps be and they are hereby appointed to View said Road and G. W. Hart be and he is hereby appointed Surveyor of the same and that they meet at the office of C. Right Esc. in Blendon Township on the Sixteenth day of Dec. 1835 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true platt and survey thereof along with their Report Return to this office on or before the 1st Monday in March 1836

Persuant to the above order I. Griswold G. Osborn and E. Phelps Jr. as Viewers and G. W. Hart as Surveyor met on the 16th day of Dec. inst and after being duly qualified according to law and taking to their assistance A. Taylor and P. Cheever as Chain Carriers and N. Cheever Jr. as Marker who were likewise duly qualified as appears by the endorsement on the above order they proceeded to View Survey and Mark the Rout agreeable to law and the directions of the aforesaid order as follows (Viz) Beg'g at a Stone Monument placed in the center of a County Road laid out and opened on the line running east and west between F. Clymers and John Cabbage which said Stone is one Rod South of the School house refeered to in the above order running from thence West on a line of lots 100 poles to the line between the Township of Plain and Blendon thence west 30 N 110 poles to a line of lots--- thence west 110 poles to the first mile Stone Same Course along said line 52 poles thence west 25 N 48 poles thence West 14 North 26 poles thence West 21 N 40 poles to a line of lots and thence West on said line 66 poles to the East Bank of Big Walnut Creek thence South 10 W. 25 poles to the W. Bank of Said Creek thence W. 16 N. 17 poles thence W. 20 South 45 poles to the center of the County Road from Columbus to Zoar (or galena) on line between Joseph Clapham and Edward Nutt thence west on said line 100 poles passing the 2 mile tree at 3 poles) to N. Cheeves line thence W 25 N 52 poles) crossing County Road past Harts at 26 poles to the line of lots between A. Taylor and P. Cheever thence west along said line 80 poles thence W 25 South 66 poles to the line between Blodgett and N. Cheever thence W. along said line 25 poles to the 3 mile tree same course along said line 161 poles thence W. 20 South 85 poles to John Bishops South East Corner thence W. along the line between said Bishops South East Corner thence W. along the line between said Bishop and N. Emery 74 poles to the 4 mile tree Same Course along said line 66 poles to the center of the State Road from Columbus to Zoar and there ending making the whole distance 4 miles 66 poles

I attended on the 10th of Sept. 1836 with the Viewers therein appointed, and Wm. Philips & B. Carr Chainmen and H. Spring marker, and having been duly qualified, we proceeded to view and Survey a proposed Road according to your Order as follows Beginning at the School House, Near Francis Clymers in Plain Township and Running thence W. 79 Rods, thence N. 53 W. 70 Rods, thence I 66 Rods, thence N. 57 W. 33 Rods, thence N. 30 1/2 W. 30 Rods N. 68 W. 42 Rods, thence W. 64 Rods, thence S. 67 1/2 W. 36 Rods, thence S. 63 W. 14 Rods thence S. 6 E. 7 Rods along the County Road thence W. 80 Rods thence N. 58 W. 45 Rods thence W. 148 Rods, Thence S. 66 W. 78 Rods, to the lane between lands, belonging to N. Chever and S. Brinkerhoof thence W. 207 Rods, N. 61 1/2 W. 48 Rods, thence W. along the North line of lands belonging to John Bishop 160 Rods to the State Road, in all four miles and twenty Seven Rods that in doing the above I spent one day Surveying and one half day in writing, marking plat &c.

Whereupon the Commissioners of franklin County,Not deeming Said Road of Sufficient importance to the Publick in general, to Pay the damages as assessed to the Complainant out of the County funds,It is there- Ordered that if the Petitioners for Said Road,Pay into the County Treasury for the use of the Complainants, the Service Amt.s.to them assessed,then said Road is hereby declared a Publick highway,and that the same be opened Sixty feet wide and made in all other Respects according to Law.
