To the honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, we the under signed freeholders and residents of the said County ~~petitioners~~ represent to your honorable body that a County Road which we will hereinafter describe will be of public and private utility and we the subscribers labor under ~~grate~~ inconvenience for the want Said Road we hope, therefor that you will take into consideration and appoint men to view said proposed Road, the Road to commence at the turnpike leading from Columbus to Worthington on the line between lots No.2 and No.3 of Rathbone Section so called in Clinton Township thence West on said line to the East bank of Whetstone River.

Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed D.Parmalee, I.Sole & B.H.Skeelds as viewers and ~~Frederick~~ Cole Surveyor that they meet at the office of L.Pinney Esq. in the Town of Worthington on the 14th Inst or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified and according to Law proceed to View Survey and mark said Road and a true platt Survey thereof along with their Report Return to this office on or before the first Monday of Dec. next 1836, Attst.

Personally appeared before me D.Parmalee, I.Sole and B.H.Skeelds as viewers and Fredrick Cole Surveyor and were Severally qualified according to law to discharge the duties enjoyned upon them by the above order,

Persuant to the annex Order I proceeded on the 17th day of June A.D. 1836 under the direction of D.Parmalee, I.Sole and B.H.Skeelds as viewers to make a Survey and location of a County Road petitioned for by I.C.Wilson and others as follows Viz: Beginning at a stake in the turnpike leading from Columbus to Worthington where the same crosses the line dividing, Lots No.2 and 3 of Rathbone Section so called in Clinton Township. Running from thence West on said line 142 poles to the East bank of the Olentangy River making the total distance one hundred and forty two Rods.

I Certify the above field notes to be correct as taken by me on the ground and that the above platt is a true protraction of the same.
