To the Hon. the Commissioners of Franklin County the petitioners of the undersigned ~~freehold~~ inhabitants of the Township of Perry, Washington and other adjoining Townships respectfully represent that a public Road Beginning at **Boysford** on the Scioto River in Perry Township to run East on the most practicable ground to the South West Corner Abner Brelford Lot # 7 T.2 S.3 R.19 thence East to said Brelford South-east corner Lot 7 Thence North on the Section line to the public Road leading from Worthington to Dublin the same has been legally advertised and your petitioners believe that a public Road on the above described Rout would be of a grate public utility, and your petitioners therefore pray that the proper and legal steps may be taken to authorize the location and establishment of said Road and will ever pray & c Jas. Roney, Amos Brelford, Daniel **Martin**, Wm Davis, Abner Brelford, Robt. Crooks, Jacob Poppaw, Saml Billingsly, Chandler Rogers, I.C. Thompson, D. Smith, John Deck, Wm. Woods, H. Brown, A. Hutchinson, ~~of~~ Jacob Wright, R.W. Cowles, N. Clark, William Murfield.

On the petition of A. Brelford and others for a New Road to commence at Boysford on the Scioto River in Perry Township to run East on the most practicable ground to the South East Corner of Abner Brelford Lot No. 7 T.2 S.3 R.19 thence East to said Brelford South East Corner of Lot 7 thence North on the Section line to the public Road Leading from Worthington to Dublin,

Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Asa Davis, Alanson Perry and Robt. Elliot as viewers and F. Cole Surveyor and that they meet at the office of Amasa Hutchinson Esq. in Perry Township on the 9th day of Sept. 1836 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to view Survey and mark said Road and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their report return to this office on or before the first Monday in Dec. next.

Purseant to the annex order I proceeded on the 9th day of Sept. 1836 under the directions of the Viewers therein named to make a Survey and location of a Road as therein directed as follows (to-wit).
Beg'g at a post on the Eastbank of Scioto River at Boysford in Perry Township from which a ~~Sycamore~~ tree about 12 inches diameter bears S. 89 E. distant 26 links from thence N. 68 1/2 E. 59 Poles to Roneys S.W. Corner thence with his line East 66 Poles thence South I pole thence East II poles thence North I Pole thence East 123 Poles to A. Brelford S.E. Corner of Lot No. 7 thence North on Section line 59 poles to a Beach marked I-mile Cont'd same Course 320 Poles to a Beach marked 2 miles Cont'd same Course 110 Poles to the Road leading from Worthington to Dublin making the total distance two miles and one hundred and Ten Rods.
I Certify the above field Notes and annex Plat to be correct.
