We the Undersigned Citizens and Freeholders of Franklin County would Respectfully represent That a County Road beginning at John Sharp Warehouse in Madison Township running with the Canal in a North - westerly direction near two miles at the point where the Canal approximates to Mathias Wolf North line in Hamilton Township thence due North to P.Wolfs Corner thence continuing North along Parkers N.line to Andrew Barrs Corner running with Sd North line a short distance to a certain point thence running in a Northwesterly course to Isaac Worthingtons Saw Mill, crossing the Bigsby Road and the gohenna Creek below the Mill dam in the Rout thence running in Northerly direction upon the Sd Creek to Sam Barrs dwelling house thence along Sd Barrs new fence in a Northwesterly direction to Sd Barrs East and West line thence due West along the Section line into the Chillicothe State Road Crossing the new int Road and passing Morris Meeting House in the Rout your petitioners would pray your honorable board to send out Viewers and establish Said Road according to law we wish it to be understood that this if granted to be a ~~Continuation~~ of a County Road already established from the Lancaster Road or Writz Grove down the toe path to John Sharps Warehouse it also connects four public Roads in a distance of from five to Six miles your petitioners will ever pray Thos.Morris, Jeremiah Clark, Saml Sharp, Joseph Sharp, John W.- Milligan, Henry Bunn, Samuel Bishop, Wm.H.Rarey, Adam Harely, Henry Plum, B.West, Mathias Wolf, Thos.Rathmell, John G. ~~Worthington~~, John Sharp, Emmor Cox, Peter Borger, James Flemming, Andrew Barr, Isaac Weatherington, Saml.- Pursel, P.Adams,

To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County, Agreeable to your Order to us directed on the - petition of Isaac Worthington and others for a new Road we meet at the house of Joseph Murray Esq. on the 29th day of December, 1836 and after being qualified according to law proceeded to the discharge of our Respective duties ; the bearings and distances are as follows Viz: Commencing at John Sharps ware- house in Madison Township on the South side of the Canal and 30 feet from the toe path thence along the South Side of said Canal N.83 $\frac{1}{2}$ W.620 poles, thence Crossing Said Canal N.33 W.20 poles to Section line- dividing Section 25 and 36 with Said Section line W.209 poles, thence N.18 W. 79 poles, thence N.34 W.36 poles to the byrbee Road, thence S.83 W.16 poles, thence N.68 W.56 poles, to the West Side of Big walnut or gahanna River Creek and Issac Weatherington Saw mill thence N.20 E.18 poles, thence N.7 E.61 poles toe Saml.Barrs dwelling house thence N.25 E.19 poles thence with Saml.Barrs New Fence N.4 W.85 poles to the Section line dividing Section 23 and 26 thence with Said Section line W.784 poles to the Chillicothe - Road Crossing new cut Road at 212 poles whole length 6 miles 83 poles. We are of the opinion that if the above named Rout for a New Road was Established it would be a public utility: for the following reasons Viz: that it connects by a direct Rout two of the most flourishing neighbourhoods in the County which - heretofore has been totally destitute and injure none materially through whose land it passes.
