To the Hon. the Commissioners of Franklin County The undersigned freeholders, Citizens of Said County would Respectfully Represent to your Honorable body that the public Convenience would be much promoted by the location and Establishment of a County Road as follows to wit Comencing on the Byxbee Road at the Old Brickyard Corner between A. Leonard and John Mc Comb on Said Byxbee Road thence due East about half a Mile thence a little North of East to the west end of Jonathan Mc Combs lane thence to follow Said lane through to intersect the Road leading from Columbus to Pickerington in Fairfield County We would therefore Respectfully ask Your Honorable body at your Next Meeting to appoint Viewers and take the further Step necessary to Establish Said Road according to the law in Such Case Made and provided All which is Respectfully Submitted by your Fellow Citizens Truro Co. Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed John Swisher Esq. Philimon Needles and Thos Hendron as Viewers of Said Road William Johnston Surveyor and that they Meet at the Office of Jonathan Mc Comb in Truro Township on the 10th day of January or within 5 days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report Make to this Office on or before the 1st Monday in March 1837

To the Hon. the Commissioners of Franklin County agreeable to Your Order to us directed. On the petition of Jonathan Mc Comb and Others for a New County Road, we met at the office of Jonathon Mc Comb in Truro Township on the 10th day of January 1837 and after being qualified according to law proceeded to the location of Said Road Bearing and distance as follows (Viz). Beginning on the Bixbee Road at the Old brickyard Corner between A. Leonard and John Mc Comb on Said Bixbee Road thence due East 155 poles, thence N. $67\frac{1}{2}$ E 54 poles thence N. 51 E. 17 poles to the west end of Jonathan Mc Combs lane thence with Said lane S. 89 E 58 poles thence N. 3 E 94 poles to the Road leading from Columbus to Pickerington in Fairfield County Whole length 1 Mile 58 poles

I Certify that the above bearings and distances are Correct taken by Me under the direction of the Viewers
