Gardner Viewers to make a Survey and location of a New County Road petitioned for by Isaiah Pursel and Others as follows Viz. Lambert Road - from the old road across Big Darby Creek to Norton Road
Norton Road - from Lambert Road to Hellbranch Creek
Kunz Road - from Johnson Road northwesterly to the intersection of Alkire Road/Alton Road (this is the original alignment)
Alton Road - from Alkire Road to the Old State Road to Springfield (this is NOT US 40; Old State Road located south of US 40)
