E. Corner thence due west on Whitesides line to the Road leading from Columbus to Blendon Township known by the harbour Road Your petitioners therefore pray your Honors to appoint Suitable Men to View Survey and locate Said Road in Conformity to the Statute in Such Case Made and provided and in duty bound will ever pray Thos. McColley Michael Ringory Albert Dean John D. Coe Robt. Innis E. Dean Dennis Farris Saml. Dalzell Adam Read G. B. Read D. W. Deshler Jas. Ferris D. Beers Wm F. Denoon W. Agler A. B. On the petition of Albert Dean et. al. for a New Road as follows; Beginning at or Near Deans

Mill in Mifflin Township from thence West Crossing Allum Creek to the line dividing the lands of Dean and McElvain thence due west on Said line dividing the lands of Dean and McElvain and Course Continued to the west line of Said Mifflin Township thence North to Whitesides N. E. Corner, thence due west on Whitesides line to the Road leading from Columbus to Blendon Township known by the harbour Road Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed John Smith Esq. John Webster and Jason Bull as Viewers of Said Road and Saml. Kinnear Esq. as Surveyor and that they meet at the office of David Beers Esq. in Mifflin Township on the----day of---- and after being duly qualified to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report Return to this office on or before the first Monday in the Month of June 1837

A Survey of a County Road beginning in Mifflin Township on the East Side of Allum Creek on the west Side of a Road leading from the City of Columbus to Blendon at a post on lands owned by McElvain thence west North 10 degs. 26 poles to the East banks of Allum Creek thence 31 degs. N. 12 poles to the west bank of Allum Creek to the line dividing the lands of Dean and McElvain thence west on Said dividing line of lands 332 poles to the East line of Clinton Township thence North on the line of Said Township 28 poles to Whitesides N. E. Corner thence west on the line of lands 182 poles to the East Side of a Road leading from Columbus to Blendon known by the harbour Road.

Agreeable to an Order to us directed from the County Comm. of Franklin County to Survey View Mark and Stake a Certain Rout for a County Road petitioned for by Albert Dean et. al. after being duly qualified according to law we have proceeded to View Survey Measure Mark and Stake Said Rout for a Road agreeable to the within plat and Survey and after Carefully Viewing the Same we are of the opinion that the ground that Said Road is laid on will admit of a good Road and if Opened and Marked will be of public benefit Clinton March 21st 1837
