We the Undersigned Citizens and land holders of Said County do Conocive that Establishing a County Road in Perry Township as follows would be of publick utility Commencing at the County Road leading from Worthington to Dublin on the tract of land that George Snoffer purchased of Richard Gale Jun. between the house and west line of Said tract thence Northerly Crossing the Run the Most practicable point thence Northerly to the North line of Said County at a point that will intersect a County Road Running Northerly through the Humphrey Settlement to the Town of Delaware therefore pray you to proceed as the law directs Feb. 11th 1837 Orlando Case C. Rodger's George Snouffer Ortho Rannebarger William Barker Isaac F. Daniels Andrew Powers Miron Hern Albert B. Herd Elisha Herd Asaph Allen Mary Wilcox, Hiram Wilcox Hiram A. Case Geo. H. Andrews S. Fisher On the petition of Orlando Case and others for a New County Road Commencing at the County Road leading from Worthington to Dublin, on the tract of land that G. Snuffer purchased of Richd. Gale Jun. between the house and West line of Said tract thence Northerly Crossing the Run at the most practicable point thence Northerly to the North line of Franklin County at a point that will intersect a County Road Running Northerly

through the Humphrey Settlement to the Town of Delaware Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Stephen Maynard Jos. Hyde and Elnathan Maynard as Viewers and Homer Tuller Surveyor of Said Road and that they Meet at the office of Chandler Rodgers Esq. in Perry Township/ on the 28th day of March 1837 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report Return to this Office on or before the Next Session of the board to be holden in the Month of June 1837

W. one Mile to a Stake and tree Marked one Mile and Continued the Same Course to a Stake and tree Marked 2 Miles Continued the Same Course to a Stake and tree Marked 3 Miles Continued the Same Course 114 Rods to the County line intersecting the Delaware County Road at that point Making the whole distance 3 Miles and 114 poles
