Residence and from thence east on Said line to the Section line thence South on Said Section line to the South west Corner of a 250 acre tract of land Owned by Said D. P. Wilcox thence East on the South line of Said 250 acre lot of land and Course Continued until it intersects the Road leading from Columbus to Blendon known by the harbour Road Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Jas. Wilcox the applicant there being No damages allowed to the Said David Beers and all and every objection having been removed We the Commissioners of Franklin Co. do hereby declare Said Road a public highway and do require the Same to be opened Sixty feet wide and Made in all Respects according to law and Notice of this order be given to the Trustees of Clinton Township

To the Commissioners of Franklin County

Gentlemen In Compliance with an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Ohio passed March 15th 1837 appointing the Undersigned as Commissioners to View a State Road laid out in 1820 by Wicks and Dustin from Columbus to Zoar in Delaware County and after being qualified as the law directs we proceeded to the performance of Said duty and after Strict examination of Said Rout and the one generally known by the harbour Road are of opinion that Said State Road as laid out by Said Wicks and Dustin is on as good ground and will be of as Much publick utility as any location that Could be Made and we do therefore Report in favor of So Much of Said Wick and Dustin Road as lies between the four Corners in Blendon where the Same intersects the harbour Road Near Robt. Innis's farm and thence to Continue Said harbour Road to the City of Columbus as now laid out And we do hereby Vacate So Much of the Said Wicks and Dustin State Road as lies between the intersection of Said State Road with the Harbour Road Near Said Robt. Innis's farm and Said City of Columbus
