Sprague and Fredrick Spragues land from thence it leaves John Hansons line South to the Hebron Road May be Vacated and established on the following ground Commence where it leaves John Hansons line to Run South about fifty Rods then to leave Said line and to Run a South Easterly direction till it Strikes the Hebron Road opposite Fredrick Spragues house and for this your petitioners will ever pray Dec. 2nd 1837 Sylvanus Baldwin Eli Miller Anson Sprague Peter Dunlap Nathan Peters William Entire Abraham Norford Niles Hanson F?
