

# Prairie South Township line

To the honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County

Gentlemen

Some time in 1827 the Commissioners then of said County altered the South line of Prairie Township so as to make the South line of Hockida tract N. 1436 the said South line of Prairie and North line of Pleasant and the course and continuation to the County line of Madison County which said continuation from said Hockida tract to County line has never been run, and of course occasions some considerable dissatisfaction among the Citizens of the said Prairie and Pleasant Townships

Your Honors will therefore have the goodness to Cause said South line of said Prairie to be run according to law, so said line may be permanently established and in duty bound will ever pray No. 25. 1837

You are hereby appointed by the Commissioners of Franklin County to run the line dividing the Townships of Pleasant and Prairie as follows (To wit)

Beginning at the S. E. Corner of the Hockida Survey N. 1436 from thence West with said line of Hockida and Course continued to the line dividing the County of Franklin and Madison Also to Commence at the S. E. Corner aforesaid and from thence East and with the Course of said Hockida line to the line dividing the Townships of Jackson and Pleasant You are also to Cause said line to be distinctly Marked throughout and a report of the same return to this office on or before the first Monday in March 1838

To the honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County Agreeable to an Order to me directed from your honorable body I proceeded on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February 1835 to run the line dividing the Township of Pleasant and Prairie as follows (To wit) Beginning at the S. E. Corner of Hockida Survey N. 1436 thence with the South line of said Survey N. 89° 30' W. 5 Miles 124 poles to the line dividing the County of Franklin and Madison running 3 1/2 poles South of Thomas Roberts Barn and about 15 poles South of Mrs Hunters House crossing Dutch Creek at the mouth of Little Dutch thence Beginning at the S. E. Corner aforesaid and running S. 89° 30' E. 1 Mile 98 poles to the line dividing the Townships of Jackson and Pleasant whole length of said line 6 Miles 222 poles I have caused said line to be distinctly Marked throughout W<sup>m</sup> Johnston Survey
