The Petition of the undersigned freeholders of Said County Respectfully Represents that their interests and Convenience and the interest and Convenience of the County, Require the location of a County Road Commencing at the Old State Road leading from Lancaster to Columbus at or Near the North west Corner of Hiram Courtright's improvement in Madison Township thence Nearly North along the west Side of Thomas Grays improvements to the line Running between Truro and Madison Township thence East with Said line to the South East Corner of Elias Chesters Jr. Improvements thence Nearly North to the New County Road leading from Alex. Mooberrys to the Truro Meeting House thence with Said Road to the East end of John Stumbaugh's lane thence North on the half Section line to the Hebron Road Near the house of James Grant thence west with Said Road or Near it to the Section Corner/ thence North with the Section line to the National Road a few Rods west of the White Hall in Truro Township and your Petitioners therefore pray that the proper and legal Steps May be taken to authorize the location and Establishment of Said Road this 20th day of January A. D. 1838 William Francher M. On the Petition of John Courtright and Others for a New County Road Commencing at the old State Road leading from Lancaster to Columbus at or Near the North west Corner of Hiram Courtright's improvements in Madison Township thence Nearly North along the West Side of Thomas Grays Improvements to the line Running between Truro and Madison Townships thence East with Said line to the South East Corner of Elias Chesters Jr. Improvements thence Nearly North to the New County Roads leading from Alex. Mooberrys to the Truro Meeting house thence with Said Road to the East End of John Stumbaugh's lane, thence North on the half Section line to the Hebron Road Near the house of James Grant, thence west with Said Road or Near it to the Section Corner, thence North with the Section line to the National Road a few rods west of the White Hall in Truro Township Whereupon the Commissioners of franklin County appointed Emanuel Cryder Edward Levingston and George White as Viewers and William Johnston as Surveyor and that they Meet at the office of Jonathan McComb Esq. in Truro Township on the 30th day of May 1838 or within five days thereafter and after being duly Qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey along with their Report Return to this office on or before the first Monday in the Month of June 1838

Improvements- thence N 14 E. 37 Poles to the County Road leading from A. Mooberrys to the Truro Meeting House- thence with Said Road N 3 W 50 Poles to the first Mile Post Same Course 20 Poles; thence N 34 W. 54 Poles- thence N 45 W. 78 Poles to the half Section line thence on Said line N 30 Poles to the East end of John Stumbaugh lane-- Same Course leaving Road 138 Poles to 2nd Mile post Same Course 274 Poles to the Hebron Road near James Grants--- thence with Said
