We the undersigned Citizens and freeholders of franklin County would Represent the Convenience/ importance, and necessity of having a publick Road for the purpose of attending Mills and Markets we therefore Most Respectfully Solicit your Hon. body to proceed as the law directs to locate and Establish a County Road of the following description to Wit, Commencing at the County line Near Darby Creek at Or near the point where the Survey line would intersect the Same which bounds the South East Side of land Owned by Robt Ross from thence to follow Said Survey line to the termination of the Same, Near the School house by Thomas T. Kains; from thence to follow the Course Or near the Course of Said Survey line to intersect the line between Philip Clover and Horace A. Riggs- thence with Said line Eastwardly following the line on the North Side of the Alex. Tract to the North East Corner of Said tract- thence due East till it intersects State Run near Peter Wilcox from thence the most direct and Convenient Rout to intersect the line dividing Eighty Acres of land Owned by Messer Clapp and Rogers on the North Side of the Said State Run thence with Said line Crossing the River Road to terminate at the Scioto River Near McCoys Mill. and your Petitioners will ever be Obliged ect. In Obedience to the above Order we the undersigned Met at Isaac Haydens and after being duly Sworn according to law we then proceeded to View but finding the Creek to high to Cross with Safety we Commenced at Isaac Haydens Mill and Viewed and laid Out proposed Rout and we Also Viewed and laid Out an additional Rout Commencing at Peter Wilcox lane Beg'g at letter B Marks on the Plat thence with a Township Road to the River Road and So on as designated by the Plat-- thence we proceeded back to the County line and Commencing at the County line and intersected the point at Isaac Haydens Mill; and we do hereby Recommend the whole to be of publick utility We do hereby Recommend the alteration Commencing at Peter Wilcox lane not insure any of the farms on the Road we Recommend that in preference to the proposed Rout which would be great damage to M. Rogers farm

Order for Opening Sent out Feby 22nd 1839

To the Honorable the Commissioners of franklin County

The Petition of the undersigned freeholders Represent that there has been a State Road Established leading from Columbus to Johnstown through Plain Township; And Said State Road intersects a County Road at David Smiths South line, the County Road Pititioned for by William Kitsmiller and Others, known, Also as the blacklick and Johnstown Road And that Said State Road Runs Nearly on the Same ground and Strikes the line of Licking County Precisly at the Place of termination of the aforesaid County Road, The County Road being both useless and Burthinsom, Your Petitioner, therefore Pray that your honorable body will Vacate So Much of Said County Road, as lies between the aforesaid Point of Intersection and the line of Licking County, And your Petitioners as in duty bound will Ever Pray ect.
