We the undersigned Citizens and freeholders of Said County petitioners Represent to your Honorable body that a County Road which we will hereinafter describe will be of publick utility we hope therefor that you will take the Same into consideration and grant a View; Road to Start at a point on the Lancaster Road in Madison Township on the Section line between Mrs. Chandler and Jacob Weaver-- thence due North on the Section line until it intersects the Byxbee Road where Said lines crosses-- being about One Mile and a half in length.-- Madison Township franklin County Ohio Thomas C. Hendron and Others for a New County Road To Start at a point on the Lancaster Road in Madison Township on the Section line between Wm Chandler and Jacob Weaver thence due North on the Section line until it intersects the Byxbee Road where Said line Crosses-- Whereupon the Commissioners of franklin County appointed Thomas Morris Percival Adams and Andrew Barr as Viewers and William Johnston as Surveyor and that they Meet at the office of Joseph Murray Esq. in Hamilton Township on the Second day of June or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road and a true plat and Survey along with their Report Return to this office on or before the first Monday in the Month of June 1838

Pursuant to the annexed order I proceeded on the first day of June 1838 under the direction of Thomas Morris Percival Adams and Andrew Barr Viewers to Make a Survey and location of a New County Road as petitioned for by Thomas C. Hendron and Others as follows (Viz) Beginning at a Stake in the Road leading from Columbus to Lancaster in Madison Township and on the Section line between Mrs Chandlers and Jacob Weaver-- thence N. 30 E. with Said Section line 320 Poles to a Stake from which a Cherry Marked 1 Mile bears N. 12 W. 42 lks. passing Section Corner at 81.7 Poles, Same Course 136 Poles to a Stake in byxby Road from which a beache Marked one Mile 136 Poles bears N. 77 W. 58 lks whole distance 1 Mile 136 Poles
