the lands of Parker Rarey and Saml Bishop at a Point where the Same Crosses the County Road leading from Circleville to the Lancaster Road Near Jacob Weaver and from the beginning Point west on Said line and Course Continued until it Strikes the bank of the high lands of Big Belly bottom, thence South on the top of Said high ground to Johnston and Herra Mills Your Petitioners therefore Pray your honorable body to appoint Suitable Men to View Survey Mark and locate Said Road in Conformity with the Statute in Such Case Made and Provided and in duty bound Will ever pray Oct. 23rd 1838 John Rohr Mathias Wolf Michael Plum Wm Rohr Jacob Reab John Herr Francis Johnston Josiah Harlow Wm Jacobs Wm Rarey Frederick Bunn Henry Bunn Charles Rarey John Gibson George Rohr Isaac Becklet Thomas Gray Joseph Sharp Wm W.
