To the Commissioners of Franklin County and State of Ohio

Your Petitioners Citizens and freeholders humbly Show that they believe the Publick Good would be Promoted by opening a County Road Beginning at the Bixby (Alin Bixby) Road where it Crosses the South line of the land of Zachariah Paull and near his dwelling house due East until it intersects the Jacksonville Road on the line between the lands of Jonathan Mc Comb and Hiram Leonard and by Vacating the Road leading from a Point Verry Near the Said Point of intersection through lands of Jonathan Mc Comb and Abner Leonard to the bixby Road, and Also by Vacating So Much of the Jacksonville Road as lies between the aforesaid Point of intersection and the Bixby Road. the advantages to the Publick will be that the Making and Repairing of less than one Mile of Road instead of about two and a half Miles will afford equal facillities to travelers and will Prevent heavy damages of a Private Nature to farms lying on the Old Roads We therefore Pray you to appoint Viewers to Said Road, and to Vacate Said Roads if in their judgement the Publick good May be Promoted thereby, And your Petitioners will ever Pray as in duty bound- John W, Long George W.
