We the Citizens of Norwich and Prairie Township that have hereunto Subscribed our Names
humbly Pray you to grant a Review on So Much of the Road from Fullers Mill on Big Darby as lies
East of Jacob Kellar to lay out and Establish a Road or Near Commencing at Jacob Kellars Stable
Running from thence to the Town of Rome on the National Road on the Most direct Rout that good
ground can be had for Said Road and to Vacate So Much of Said Road as Now is established East of
Said Jacob Kellars for which Your humble Petitioner will ever Pray- William Champ, Thos O'Harra,
John Comley, Henry Sims, Ezekiel Kellar, John Robinson, Jacob Conkel, Joby Postle, Henry Sly, Stephen Postle
James Sly, John Brown, John Postle, Daniel Brown, J. J. Zimmer, Henry Bowen Blenkner Levi Wiley- On
the Petition of Ezekiel Kellar and Others for an Alteration of a Part of the County Road leading
from Fullers Mill to intersect the National Road Near the Georgesville Road to Commence at Jacob
Kellars Stable Running from thence to the Town of Rome on the National Road on the Most direct
Rout that good ground Can be had for Said Road- Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County
appointed George Skidmore William Wilson and Robt Brackenridge as Viewers and Wm Johnston as Sur-
veyor or and that they Meet at the office of Miskell Saunders Esq. on the Eighteenth day of Dec.
Or within five thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law Proceed to View Survey
and Mark and locate Said alteration and a true Flat and Survey along with their Report Return to
this office on or before the first Monday in the Month of March 1839

ection of George Skidmore William Wilson and Robt Brackenridge Viewers to Make a Survey and
location of an alteration in the County Road leading from Fullers Mill to intersect the Nati-
onal Road Near the Georgesville Road Petitioned for by E. Kellar and Others Viz. Beginning at
a Stake in Said Road from which the North East Corner of Jacob Kellars Stable bears S. 17 W.
62 lks in Norwich Township- thence S. 76 E. 58 Poles to an Oak angle tree- thence S. 85 E. 39
Poles to the line dividing the lands of Ezekial Kellar and John Zimmer- thence with Said line
S. 10 1/2 E. 50 Poles to a Hickory angle tree Crossing the line dividing the Township of Norwich
and Prairie at 25 1/2 Poles- thence S. 9 1/2 E. 84 Poles- thence N. 86 E. 58 Poles to the Eastern
boundry of Survey No 6641 thence with Said Survey line S. 10 1/2 W. 31 Poles to an Oak Marked 1
Mile Same Course 89 Poles- thence leaving Said Survey line S. 7 E. 231 Poles to an Oak Marked
2 Mile- thence S. 32 E. 147 Poles- thence S. 5 E. 38 Poles to the National Road in the Town of
Rome Whole distance 2 Miles and 185 Poles Field Notes of the Old Road Beginning at the Same
Point as the New Road- thence S. 117 1/2 E. 150 Poles- thence S. 10 E. 56 poles thence S. 60 E.
779 Poles- thence S. 65 E. 128 Poles to the National Road at the intersection of Georgesville
Road. Whole distance 3 Mile 158 Poles Making a difference of 288 Poles between the Roads to
the National Road- I Certify the above field Notes to be Correct as taken by Me On the Ground
and that the above plat is a true Protraction of the Same
