Kellars Stable in Norwich Township thence East to the line between E. Kellars and J. Zimmers thence South with Said line to the Township line between Norwich and Prairie and Franklin thence East with Said line to the Mouth of the lane Near T. Webbs- thence to intersect the County Road leading from Worthington to Georgesville your Petitioners therefore Pray your honorable body to appoint Suitable Men to View Survey Mark and locate the Same in Conformity with the Statute in Such Case Made and Provided and in duty bound will Ever Pray Nov. 1st 1838

Pursuant to the annexed order I proceeded on the 19th of Dec. 1838 under the direction of Peter Clover Stephen Postle and Job Postle Viewers to Make a Survey and location of a New County Road Petitioned for by Jacob Kellar and Others as follows Viz. Beginning at a Stake in the Road leading from Fullers Mill to intersect the National Road Near the Georgesville Road from which the North East Corner of Jacob Kellars Stable bears S. 17 W. 62 lks in Norwich Township-- thence S. 76 E. 58 Poles to an Oak angle tree-- thence S. 85 E. 39 Poles to the line dividing the land of Ezekial Kellar and John Zimmer- thence with Said line S. 10 E. 25 1/2 Poles to the line dividing the Township of Norwich Prairie in Franklin- thence with Said Township line N. 75 1/2 E. 197 1/2 Poles to an Elm Marked 1 Mile Same Course 320 Poles to a beach Marked 2 Mile Same Course 158 Poles- thence N. 82 1/2 E. 8 Poles to Miskell Saunders South West Corner- thence with Saunders line N 64 1/2 E. 154 Poles to an Oak Marked 3 Mile Same Course 314 Poles to a Stake in the Road leading from Worthington to Georgesville at the East End of Thos Webbs lane- Whole distance 3 Mile 314 Poles- I Certify the above field Notes to be Correct as taken by Me On the ground and that the above Plat is a true Protraction of the Same
