To the Commissioners of Franklin County State of Ohio  
 The petition of the undersigned respectfully represents that their  
 interest and convenience require the alteration of so much of the  
 line between Prairie and Pleasant Townships in said County as  
 lies between the West Corner of Hookiday Survey in the Original  
 Township line and the western line of the County of Franklin and your  
 petitioners pray further that said Township line be located as follows  
 viz to 1/2 Digg at the west corner of Hookiday Survey in the Original Town-  
 ship line - thence Northwesterly on a straight line to the Cedar hill on the  
 East bank of 1/2 Dig Darby opposite Henry Clovers farm - thence on  
 1/2 Dig Darby thence to 1/2 Dig Lillys house leaving that on the South  
 of said line thence on a straight line to the West side of the leading  
 from Gardner Mill to the Cumberland road where said road crosses  
 the line between Madison and Franklin Counties and your petitioners  
 therefore pray that the proper and legal steps be taken to authorize  
 the location and establishment of said Township line and will ever  
 pray this Eighth day Oct. 1838

Pursuant to the annexed Order I proceeded on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1839  
 to make an alteration in the Township line dividing the Townships of Pleasant  
 and Prairie as follows viz. Digg at the South West Corner of 1/2 Hookiday Survey  
 in the original line of said Township, and from thence N. 58 W. three Miles 1136  
 to a Sycamore marked 3 Miles 193 Poles at the foot of the Water Cedar hill opp-  
 to H. Clovers farm Crossing the road leading from Georgetown to Columbus  
 330 Poles marked a W. date T. D. J. - thence N. 78 W. 1 Mile 176 Poles to the  
 County line where the road leading from Gardner Mill to the National  
 road crosses said County line Crossing 1/2 Dig Darby Creek at 80 Poles and  
 leaving the residence of 1/2 Dig Lilly on the South of said line
