In obedience to the annexed order the undersigned after having been duly qualified as the law directs- Proceeded on the 14th day of May 1839 to take John Agler and David Beers Esq. as Chain Carriers and David Dill as Marker and measure the County Road Specified in Said order as petitioned for by Henry Innis et. al. as follows (Viz) Commencing at a Stake Set in the Center of the publick Road leading from Columbus to Galena at the intersection of Said Road Near the Brick School house in Mifflin Township and Running from thence West 310 Poles to the west line of John Kissingers land thence South 29 Poles along

Said line to a Stake Set in the Center of Said Road Making the whole distance One Mile and 19 Poles

In the further performance of the duties the undersigned proceeded to Survey and Mark the Rout proposed for the alteration of the above Referred to Road as directed in Said Order as follows Commencing at the Stake Set in the West line of Kissingers lot at the termination of the above Survey and Running from thence East 265 Poles- thence South 49 E. 12 Poles to the East Side of Allum Creek- from thence North 81 East 19 Poles to the Center of the State Road leading from Columbus to Galena as aforesaid Making the whole distance of the proposed alteration 296 Poles Making a difference of the two Routs Surveyed of 43 Poles in favor of the alteration- Respectfully Submitted
