To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County

The undersigned petitioners freeholders and Citizens of Said County, represent to your honorable body the necessity of an alteration in a part of the State Road leading from London Madison County via Lockbourne in said Franklin County via Lithopolis to Lancaster Fairfield County, Said alteration to Commence in the Town of Lockbourne, at a point where Commerce Street Makes an angle near where Said Street Crosses the Ohio Canal, from thence with the Course of Said Street until it strikes the line dividing the lands of Jacob Plumb and Thos Vanse, thence East on said line and Course Continued for near 1 Mile from thence Southward to or near the Southwest Corner of H. Dildines land on the line dividing the lands of said Dildine and H. Brown, thence East in said line and Course Continued to a point where a Southwardly line will strike the line dividing the lands of Hulvy and Grooms thence on said line East until it intersects the Old laid out Road at Grooms ford on little Walnut Creek And your petitioners therefore pray your honorable body to appoint suitable Men to view said alteration and locate the same agreeable to the Statute in such Case made and provided, and your petitioners in duty bound will ever pray April 29, 1839.
