To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County,

the undersigned your petitioners freeholders in Said County beg leave to represent to your honorable body the necessity of an alteration in part of the State Road leading from Worthington, to Galena Said alteration to commence at Some point South of the North line of Lot No. 70 and to intersect the Columbus and Sandusky Turnpike on Lot No. 30 your petitioners therefore pray your honorable body to appoint Suitable Men to view Survey Mark and locate Said Road alteration, and vacate so much of the old Road as lays between the beginning point of Said Pike, and in duty bound will ever pray Oct. 25th 1839. Johnson and others for an alteration of a part of State Road from Worthington to Galena as follows Commencing on Said Road at Some point South of the N. line of Lot No. 70 and to intersect the Columbus and Sanduskey Turnpike on Lot No. 30. Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County Appointed K. Neil R. Cutter and A. Penney as Viewers and U. Lathrop Surveyor of Said Road and that they meet at the Office of L. Pinny Esq in the Town of Worthington on the 4 day of February and after being duly Qualified According to law proceed to view Survey, and locate said alteration and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their Report make to this board according to law On Or before the 1st Monday in March 1840

Notes relating to a Survey made for an alteration on the location of the Southern part of the Galena State Road Commencing at the North line of Lot No. 70 at the center of Said Road and Run South 63 W. 80 Poles to a Stake in the South line of No. 70 thence S. $49\frac{1}{2}$ W. 52 Poles to a Stake thence S. $35\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 Poles to the center of the Columbus and Sanduskey Turnpike from which an ash 20 inches in diameter Stands N. $76\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 Links thence South 58 Poles to the North line of the Town platt of Worthington Whole distance 250 Poles

The Present location is as follows Commencing at the Same point in the North line of the Town of Wprthington and Run North 22 Poles thence N. $43\frac{1}{2}$ E. 214 to the North line of Lot No. 70 Whole distance 236 Poles, the annexed Plat is a Correct protraction of the Same
