

# Survey of Norwich and Washington Township line

State of Ohio Franklin County  
 To the Commissioners of Franklin County, we your petitioners respectfully represent that from the course the Division line now runs between Washington and Norwich Townships it leaves the inhabitants in the S. W. part of Washington partly in behind Norwich, and as the elections are held at the Town of Dublin another extremity of the Township it subjects the inhabitants in the part aforesaid to great inconvenience to attend elections and other Township business, as many have to travel at least six miles over werry bad roads to get there so that some who would leave to assert their Rights are constrained to stay at home. Your petition would ask that you would take the matter into consideration and attach the part aforesaid to Norwich Township and should you think it expedient to grant the prayer of your petition we beg would suggest that the line between the two Townships should begin at Seito's River at the mouth of "Headens Run" thence up said Run into a lane on a line between Smith Gulin and William Harris Esq. thence the course of that line Westly to Brown Township line or if that better to follow up the Creek only to the line between Caleb Keizer and Smith Gulin thence Westly the course of that line to Brown Township the latter is perhaps preferable as it will not interfere with School districts already laid off and will fully meet the prayer of your petition and will forever stay -

S. Military Lands, and from thence West 12° South and course continued untill it strikes the East line of Brown Township it being the west line of Pelham's Survey N<sup>o</sup> 6366

 Gentlemen: Agreeable to the within Order I went on the ground and ran the line according to the following Notes. Commencing at the Seito's River near the mouth of "Headens Run" and run S. 75° W. 30 Poles to a sugar standing near the north side of the Road leading from Columbus to Dublin and at the intersection of a new County Road now opening thence S. 75° W. 30 Poles thence S. 88° W. 20 Poles thence S. 87° W. 30 Poles thence S. 78° W. 40 Poles thence S. 70° W. 60 Poles thence S. 60° W. 100 Poles thence S. 66° W. 40 Poles thence S. 70° W. 60 Poles thence S. 75° W. 20 Poles thence South 73° W. 20 Poles thence S. 70° W. 280 Poles thence S. 75° W. 270 Poles thence S. 80° W. 50 Poles thence South 80° W. 100 Poles to the line between Keizer and Gulin thence S. 80° W. 134 Poles thence S. 80° W. 200 Poles to a stake at a Hickory in the East line - Brown Township's Total 4 miles and 230 Poles
