Corner of said survey, thence on the best and most direct line to M. Alkires lane, thence with said lane and with the present travelled road to intersect the Highland road at Alexr Whites., Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County Appointed Joseph Chinoweth, Joseph Morgan, and Peter Clover as Viewers, and William Johnston as Surveyor and that they meet at the Office of William Walker Esq on the tenth day of May 1839. or within five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed to View, Survey, Mark, and locate said road, and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their report return to this office on or before the first Monday in the month of June 1839.
