To the honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County

We the Undersigned do conceive that it would be for the public good if there was a Road laid out and established according to law, Viz. Commencing at Shubal Fuller's Run on the west line of Franklin County thence to run on an Eastwardly course on the line dividing the line of James and Shubal Fuller to the line of Madison County, and your petitioners will ever pray for your honors to grant the Same William Harris, Philip Caton, Smith Dulin, David G. Vauschoyck, Smith Bailey, John Schofield, John Kiser, John Vanschoyk, Amos Kidwell James O. S. Langton, Robert Roberts, Merit Rendell, Jonathan Bigelow, Ananias Harris, Knowlton Bailey, James Fuller On the Petition of William Harris and others, praying for the location of a New County Road to Commence at Shubal Fullers Run on the west line of Franklin County, thence to run an Eastwardly Course on the line dividing the lands of James and Shubal Fuller to the line of Madison County

Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Henry McCracken, Asa Davis and William Armisted Viewers and Uriah Lathrop Surveyor and that they meet at the office of William Harris Esqr. in Washington Township on the 28th day of December 1840 Or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed to View, Survey, Mark, and locate Said road according to law, and a true plat and Survey thereof along with their report return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of March 1841

To the Commissioners of Franklin County In accordance with the accompanying order I did on the 29th day of December 1840 proceed to Survey and lay out a County Road under the direction of Mess. H. McCracken, William Armisted and Asa Davis agreeable to the following field Notes, to wit, " Beginning at a Stake in Fullers Run So Called, in the West line of Franklin County, and run N. 53 E. 266. Poles, intersecting the County line of Madison and Franklin, The accompanying plat is a correct protraction of the Same.
