To the Commissioners of Franklin County to wit:

This is to certify that

Chauncey Cook & Fanny Buck (Administratrix) of John Buck
have agreed that the road may be opened on the lines between
their Farms.

relinquished, it is ordered that said road be henceforth a public
highway, and that the same be opened and made in all respects
according to law, and that notice of this Order be given to the Trustees of
