To the Honorable Commissioners of Franklin County Ohio Gentlemen, "

The undersigned Citizens of Said County of Franklin Respectfully represent that a Road Commencing near the Bank of the Ohio Canal where the road leading from Middletown to the Lancaster and Columbus Road Crosses Said Canal, and running thence Northeastwardly to the line between Fairfield and Franklin Counties would be of much public utility, and especially beneficial to the people of that Vicinity. We therefore ask that a County Road be located. Commencing, running, Terminating as above January 23rd 1841.-- John B. Thompson, Jacob T. Decker, Benjamin Wooden, Hiram Hendron, G. T. Wheeler, Henry Delinger, Samuel Leigh, Jesse Welton, Harvey Strode, Henry Dildine Jr. Isaac Seylour Isaac L. Decker, Milton Cummings, David D. Van.Trine, Elisha B. On the petition of John B. Thompson and others for a New County Road Commencing Near the bank of the Ohio Canal, where the road leading from Middletown to the Lancaster and Columbus Road, Crosses said Canal, and running thence Northeastwardly to the line between Fairfield and Franklin Counties.

Whereupon The Commissioners of Franklin County appointed John Wintersteen, Thomas Patterson, and Thomas Needles Viewers and A. V. Taylor Surveyor, and they meet at the Office of James Piercy Esq. in

Madison Township on the 10th day of April 1841, or within five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to Law, proceed to View, mark, and locate said Road, and a true plat, and Survey along with your report return to this Office on or before the first Monday in the Month of June 1841.

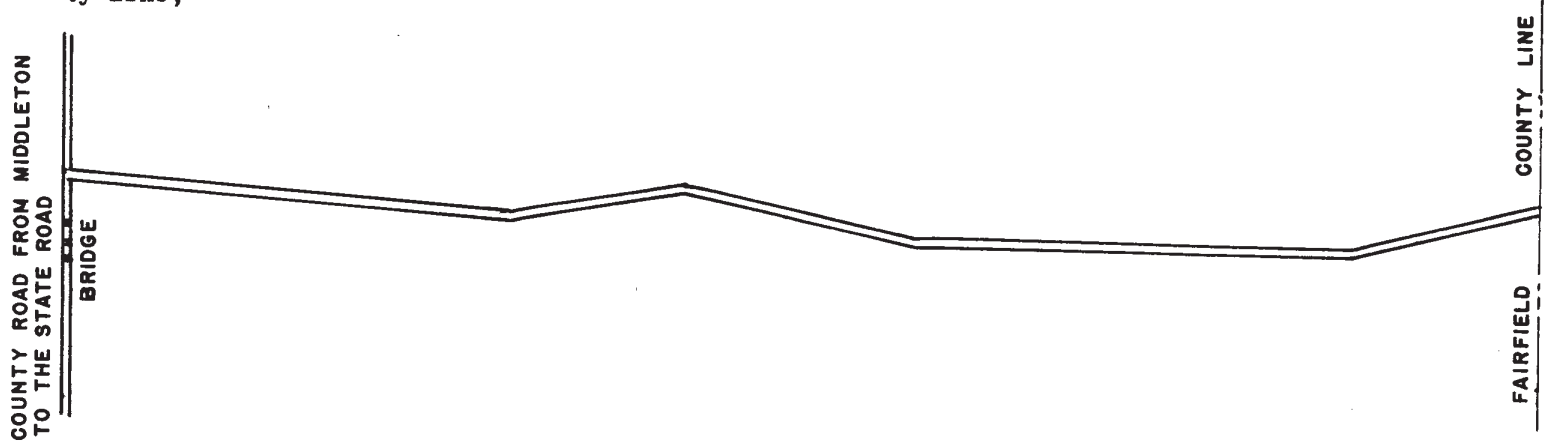

Thence N. 81. E. 20 poles, a post. Thence S. 77. 26. poles a post. Thence E 48 poles a post Thence 75 N. E. 20 poles, to a post in the Fairfield County line,



intersection of the Fairfield County Road the whole distance 164. poles, and passing as near the burn bank of the Canal as the ground will admit for a Road without obstructing the Canal April 10th 1841.
