The petition of the undersigned Freeholders and Citizens of Franklin County respectfully represent, that they conceive, that the interest and convenience of the Public as well as individuals requires a location of a County Road, Commencing at a point in the Road leading from Rome in Prairie Township to the Oposom Run road due West from the (N. W. Corner of Foster's Survey No. 1462,) from thence East to Said Corner and with the North line of Said Survey to the N. E. Corner thereof, thence to the S. E. Corner of James Haynes field, thence on the most Suitable route to intersect the road leading from the Highland to the Georgesville road at the house of Mahlon Peters in Franklin Township, and your Petitioners therefore Pray that the proper and legal steps may be taken to authorize the location and establishment of Said road, and your petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray. John Hall, David Kinnaird, Job Postles, J. S. Hickman, Benjamin Holt, Gillimus Demorest, Jacob Neff, Gershman M. Peters, Wm Gardner, Mahlon Huddleson, Israel Brown, Wm Manning.

On the petition of John Hall and others for a new County roads, Commencing at a point in the road leading from Rome in Prairie Township to the Oposom Run Road due West from the Northwest Corner of Foster's Survey No. 1462 from thence East to Said Corner, and with the north line of Said Survey to the Northeast Corner thereof, Thence to the Southeast-Corner of James Haines field, thence on the most Suitable route to intersect the road leading from the Highland to the Georgesville Road at House of Mahlon Peters in Franklin Township.

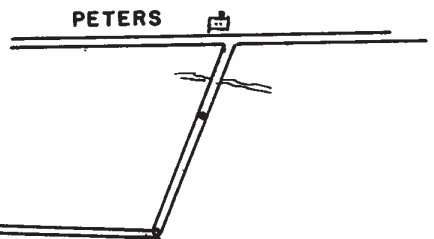
Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed John Perrin, Nathan Cole and Samuel Deardurff Viewers, and John Graham Surveyor, and that they meet at the Office of Wm Caldwell Esq. in Franklin Township on the 17th day of March 1841 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law, Proceed to View, Survey, Mark and locate Said Road, and a true Plat and Survey thereof along with their Report return to this Office, On or before the first Monday in the month of June 1841.

I do hereby Certify the above named Samuel Deardurff John Perrin, Nathan Cole and John Graham were duly sworn before me according to law to perform their respective duties as viewers and Surveyor of the Road named in the above Order March 17th 1841

Pursuant to the annexed Order, I proceeded on 17th day of March 1841, under the direction of the Viewers therein named to make a Survey of the Road as petitioned for as follows Viz. Beginning at a point in the County Road leading from Rome in Prairie Township to the Georgesville Road, and west of the S. W. Corner of John Foster's Survey No. 1462, Thence running East 18 poles to an elm and hickory N. W. Corner to said Foster's Survey, thence S. 85 E. 48 poles to a hickory N. E. Corner of Absolom Peter's lands, thence East 254 poles to 1st Mile Post, Same Course Continued 176 poles the South line of Holman Minnis Survey No. 1425, thence with the South line of Said Survey S. 78 E. 100 poles to the mouth of Peter's lane, thence with Said lane N. 21 45' E. 44 poles to 2 Mile Post, Same Course Continued 24 poles Crossing Scioto Big Run at 12 Poles to the Centre of the County Road leading up Said Run in front of Mahlon Peter's house the place of termination, Making the total distance 2 Miles & 24 Poles
