

COUNTY ROAD ALTERATION OF

BY H. A. RIGGS AND OTHERS

ROW = 60' by law

To the Commissioners of Franklin County, State of Ohio.

We the undersigned Citizens of Franklin County, would represent to your Honorable body the necessity of an alteration of a part of the County road leading from near Hayden's Mill on darby Creek to Scioto River.

Commencing at or near what is termed the White Oak Corner near James Huggetts, thence with his line to his Corner near Thomas T. Kanes, thence with the line between Said Huggett and Kane till it intersects the County Road passing through said Kanes land where it is now open, thence with Said Road till opposite the line between said Kane and Owen Roberts, thence with said line to the Corner of Philip Clovers, thence with Clovers South line till it intersects the County Road between Brown and Norwich Townships, thence with said Road till it intersects the first said Road, and to vacate such part of said Road as becomes useless by such alteration, and your petitioners will ever pray. H. A. Riggs, James Huggett, Philip Clover, Thomas T. Kane, James Boyd, William Richards, Owen Roberts, J. S. Rogers, George Wilcox, Thomas Marshall, William Morris, Lewis Roberts, George Riggs, Warren Frazell.

On the Petition of Horace A. Riggs and others praying for an alteration of a part of the County Road leading from near Haydens mill on Darby Creek to Scioto River, Commencing at or near what is termed the White Oak Corner near James Huggetts, thence with his line to his Corner near Thomas T. Kanes, thence with the line between said Huggett and Kanes till it intersects the County Road passing through said Kanes land where it is now opened thence with said Road till opposite the line between Said Kane and Owen Roberts, thence with Said line to the Corner of Philip Clovers, thence with Clovers South line till it intersects the County Road between Brown and Norwich Townships, thence with Said Road till it intersects the first said road and to vacate such part of said road as becomes useless by such alteration.

Whereupon, the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Joseph OHarra, Israel Brown, and Knowlton Bailey Viewers and John Graham Surveyor, and that they meet at the Office of Jacob S. Rogers Esq. in Brown Township on the 15th day of June 1841 or within five days thereafter and after being duly qualified according to law proceed to view Survey mark and locate said road according to law, and a true Plat and Survey along with their report return to this Office On Or before the first Monday in the Month of December 1841.

The State of Ohio, Franklin County S S Personally appeared before me the within named Israel Brown, Knowlton Bailey and Jas. OHarra Viewers, and John Graham Surveyor, and were duly sworn to discharge their respective duties as Viewers and Surveyor of the road named, in the within order.

June 15, 1841

Pursuant to the annexed order I did on the 15th dau of June 1841 under the direction of Knowlton Bailey, Isarel Brown and Joseph OHarra Viewers, proceeded to Survey, locate and mark an alteration of a certain County Road as named in said Order to Wit, Beginning at the Southeast corner of Richd. Stephenson's Survey a large White Oak and ash running thence with the line dividing the lands of James Hugget and Edward Bunner N. 7 E. 20 poles to Said Huggets N. W. Corner, thence East with the line dividing the lands of Thomas T. Kane and said Hugget 88 poles to a County Road leading from near Fuller's Mill to the National Road, thence with Said Road, N. 1 W. 95 poles to where said Kanes north line crosses said road thence S. 89 E. with said line passing Owen Roberts S. W. Corner at 15 1/2 poles 114 poles to a Pin Oak Said Kanes N. E. Corner, thence South with Said Kanes east line 3 poles to an Ash 1 Mile Tree, Same Course Continued 6 poles to three beeches, Philip Clovers S. W. Corner, thence with his South line N. 81 1/2 E. passing a Corner of said Clover at 58 poles and another at 143 poles 231 poles to a County road leading from the Fuller Mill road to the national road, thence with said road N. 9 W. 50 poles to where the present road crosses Said County Road, making the total distance 1 Mile and 287 poles, and the distance between the same points on the present route is 1 Mile and 190 poles.

I do hereby Certify the above field notes to be correct as taken by me on the ground, and that the above Plat is a true Protraction of the Same.

To the Honorable the Commissioners of Franklin County, Gentlemen, Agreeably to an Order to us directed from your Honorable body in answer to a petition of Horace A. Riggs and others for an alteration of a part of the County Road leading from near Haydens Mill on Darby Creek to the said River, We proceeded on the day named in said Order to View the proposed and also the present route of said Road between the points named in said Order, and caused the location of said alteration which in Our opinion is on as suitable ground as the present road, that it is laid so as not to injure lands of individuals, whereas the present established road runs so as to essentially injure Some lots, For these reasons we are of the opinion that said alteration Should be granted.
