

Crossing the East branch of Darby Big Run at 8 poles / to a post another Corner to their land, thence with another of their lines S. 84 W. 83 poles to an Ash another corner to said Clover's land, thence with another of their lines North 58 poles to a hickory angle tree in Said line, thence N. 62 W. 34 poles to angle post in another line of said Clover's land, thence West 30 poles to the S. W. corner of Said Clover's land, thence with another of their lines N. 11 W. 28 poles to angle post in the line of George Galloway's land, thence N. 66 W. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ poles to White Oak One mile Tree, Same Course Continued 131 poles to Wm Brown's lane, thence with said lane S. 82 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 86 poles to angle post, thence N 82 W. 52 poles to Thomas Crabbs S. E. Corner, thence with said Crabb's line West 51 poles to two mile tree Same Course Continued 15 poles to Said Crabbs S. W. Corner, thence S 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. with the line of William Darks survey No. 1046 180 poles to the County road leading from the 10 Mile Stone to Amity, the place of termination, whole distance 2 Miles and 195 Poles.
