Ashbaugh Road - from the County line to Brand Road

We the undersigned do lay before the County Commissioners of Franklin County Washington Township Franklin County would respectfully petition to have a County Road Commencing at the New County road on the Delaware County line at Isaac Crts running south through the land of Cyrap Ashbaugh, thence South through Walter Dun to intersect the Marysville State road at or near Hugh Hunter. Oct. 12, 1841. Cyrus Ashbaugh, John Huston, Hugh Huston, Hugh Mitchell, Charles Howey, John Filler, William Howey, William Waggoner, John McKim, Isaac Artz, Elisha M. Glick, James E. Donaldson, James Donaldson, Wm Sells, Henry Caffman, A. Hutchinson, Isaac Denas, John Graham, John Eberly, Z. Hutchinson, D. W. Thomas, Thomas Sands, Orange Bailey, John Urton.

On the petition of Cyrus Ashbaugh and Others for a New County road, commencing at the new County road on the Delaware County line at Isaac Artz, running South through the land of Cyrus Ashbaugh thence South through Walter Dun's to intersect the Marysville State road at Or near Hugh Hustons, Whereupon the Commissioners of Franklin County appointed Griffith Thomas, Joseph Davis, and Amos Brelsford as Viewers and Uriah Lathrop as Surveyor and that they meet at the Office of John Eberly Esq. in Washington township on the 13th day of January 1842. or with five days thereafter, and after being duly qualified according to law, proceed to view, survey, mark and locate said road and true plat and Survey thereof along, with their report return to this Office on or before the first monday in the month of March 1842.
