

To the Hon. the Commissioners of Franklin County,

The undersigned petitioners householders and residents of Brown and Prairie townships most respectfully represent that in their opinion the interest and convenience of the inhabitants of those townships require an alteration of the boundary of Brown township so as to include the lot of land in Survey No. 237 on which William Clover now lives within the limits of Prairie township.

Beginning where the east line of Brown township crosses the North line of said Clover's land; thence with the north line thereof west to the Northwest corner of said land; thence with the west line south to the Southwest corner thereof in the present South line of Brown township; and in case Brown township has no more than its constitutional limits, we further pray for an alteration which shall attach a part of Prairie to Brown township as follows: Beginning where the present South line of Brown township crosses Darby Creek, and on the West side thereof; thence down the Creek with its meanders to the lower corner on said Creek to St. Croixes Survey No. 2679; thence with the South line thereof, easterly to the County line, and your petitioners as in duty bound will ever pray.
